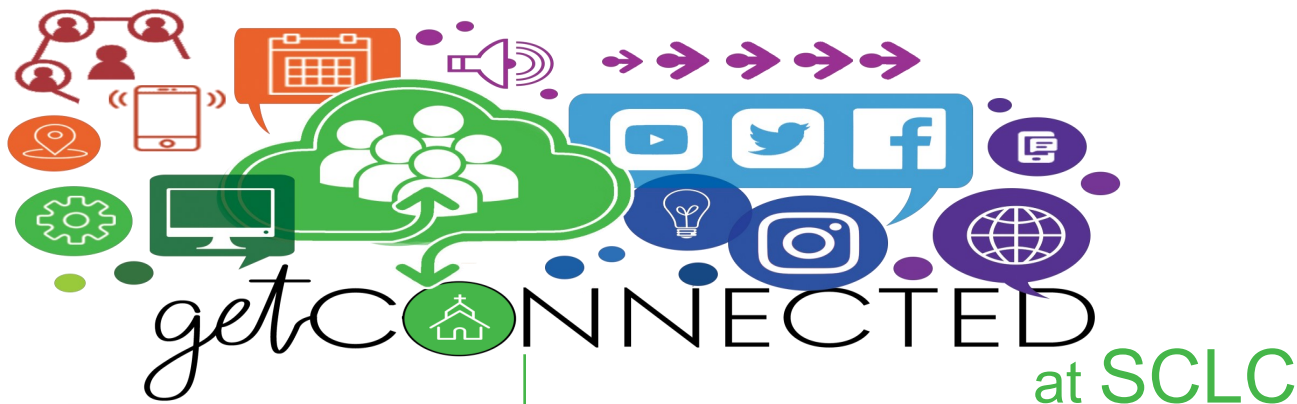

Dear Friends in Christ,

I love the changing of the seasons; how the world looks different and smells different and feels different as each season brings unique changes. Just as I am getting weary of the summer heat here comes fall; as winter's cold has finally chilled me to the bone spring brings the hope of new life. When I pause to think about it, there are seasons, rhythms, to everything: economics, business, life, the church.

I was thinking back to the seasons I have experienced at SCLC since I arrived in 2018. I remember poignantly the stress of 2019 and 2020. That was a season of struggle and division and bone chilling change—but I also remember some unique fun things that came out of that season. (I don't want to go back....but still). I remember how Pastor Erik and I would sit down in front of a camera every week and film a bible study on the book of Acts. We even had a theme song—ask Pastor Erik to sing it sometime. We journeyed together through Acts, using scripture to make sense of the season of loss and separation and fear. In Acts the early church was dealing with so much transformation, new things were happening, old things were being let go of and as fear tried to reign, Holy Spirit was ever-present leading people to find joy.

This week a passage from Acts 27 came to my attention. In the story Paul is sailing to Rome under Roman Guard. While crossing the sea they not only encounter a storm but are completely taken by its power and unable to get away so that they "gave way to it and were driven". They are beaten by the storm for 14 days, until "neither sun nor stars appeared for many days, and no small tempest raged, all hope of our being saved was at last abandoned." It was at this point that Paul urged the men to take some food, proclaimed that in the midst of this terrible experience, they will not die but all will live. Then Paul took bread, gave thanks in the presence of all and broke and ate. All 276 persons on the ship ate food and ... well you will have to read Acts 27 to see how the story turns out but here is what I find inspiring:

Paul gave thanks during the storm, not afterwards. In the midst of that terrible season of wind and rain and hunger and fear and ever-present threat of death Paul turns to God in thanksgiving. The storm was still there but so was God. I have been thinking about finding thanksgiving in the midst of the different seasons of life for all sorts of reasons these days. For me Paul's actions are not just a change in perspective but a commitment to faithful action. Our Faith in God is how we can give thanks in the midst of life's stormy seasons. Seasons come and go, storms ebb and flow, change is constant but so is the loving presence of God, so that even when all hope of being saved is gone—we can eat of the bread of life and know that God is with us and Give Thanks.

May God's Peace in Christ be with you,

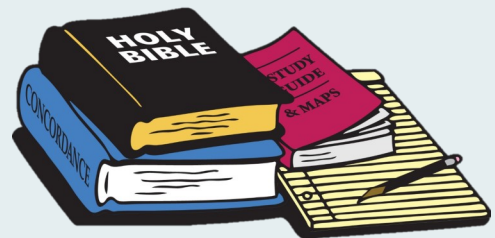

Council Minutes - September 12, 2022

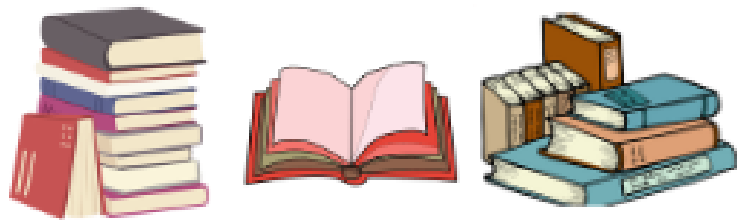
Here are highlights from the September meeting:

- August Minutes: Approved
- Financials: Income for August was about \$45k. Expenditures were about \$63k, with a negative difference of about \$17K. In contrast, the difference in August 2021 was a negative 13k.
- Council President and Vice president will be meeting with staff members in the upcoming month for reviews of ministry/job descriptions and current work.
- Building and Grounds: parking lot will be sealed in September; Outdoor Space Committee has begun meeting and a door was added between the preschool rooms to facilitate a more positive and interactive classroom environment.
- Council is planning a council retreat: dates to be determined .

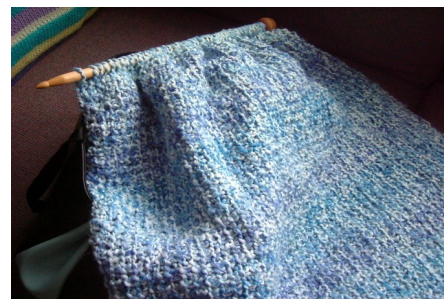
Pastoral Care

GIVING TREE All gifts collected will be given to Treasured Lives.

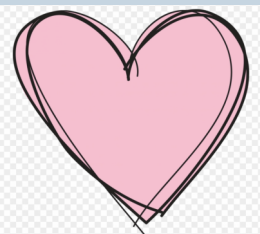

Skip the Tax!

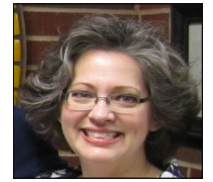

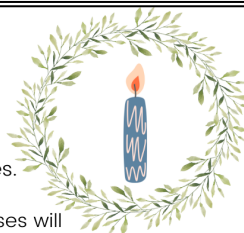
Take Home Family Advent Kits
