A MESSAGE FROM CHURCH COUNCIL AND PASTOR CHRIS BAESLER

Dear Siblings in Christ,

Christ is Risen! I hope you had a blessed Easter season. I know I was blessed by our Easter worship together and your presence. There seems to be a lot of positive energy around worship and I celebrate the Holy Spirit’s work among us in that way. Praise be to God.

(November is our fall meeting: the focus is program/ministry review and budget approval). The order of business will be as follows: Opening Devotion, Approval of Minutes, Leadership Reports, Elections, and Old/New Business. Old/New Business will be:

- Budget and Financial Update
- Congregational Vitality Survey Results
- Call Process
- Outdoor Space Update
- Other...

I look forward to seeing you at the Semi-Annual Meeting and to the work God promises to be doing among us; and God is faithful. Ministry of the Month – One Heart Ministry

Throughout each month we collect a special offering for a ministry in our community that provides needed services to many in the area and this month is **OneHeart – A Place for Hope and Healing**.

The purpose of the OneHeart transformational campus is to elevate the human spirit and the spirit of the Rapid City community. By providing transitional housing and co-locating a variety of services – from addiction and mental health counseling to life skills and job training – they can efficiently, effectively and collectively create pathways out of poverty for those desiring to thrive.



The four-acre campus, located at 217 Kansas City Street, brings opportunities to create how the Rapid City community addresses poverty and housing insecurity. OneHeart seeks to move people out of that situation entirely, rather than continuing to treat the symptoms of poverty. The goal for guests is that they have permanent housing and steady employment when they leave campus. If the cycle of poverty can be broken for families, lives will be changed for future generations while boosting the local workforce.

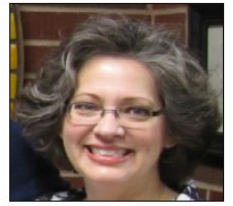

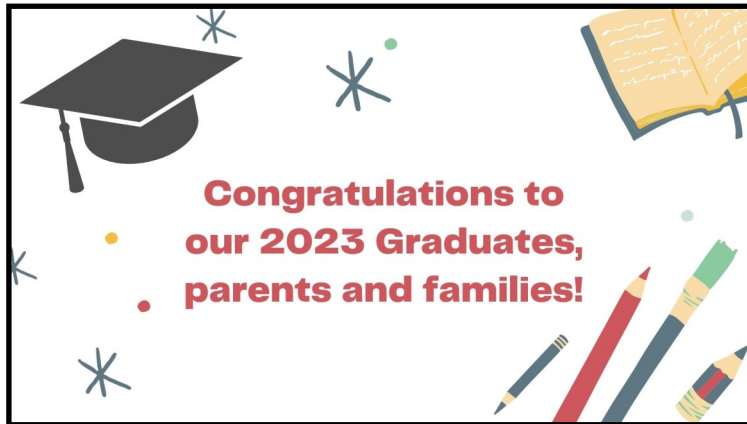


