A MESSAGE FROM CHURCH COUNCIL AND PASTOR CHRIS BAESLER



Dear Siblings in Christ,

Now is a most meaningful time to be God's church. The rapid socio-economic-cultural changes we are experiencing as a society make the church's message of love and God's abiding presence a powerful witness in the world. I believe God has a unique mission and purpose for SCLC and for each of you to make God's love known in new ways amidst the changing landscape of the world. It is important that we explore this together. Church leadership author Susan Beaumont says in her book <u>How to Lead When You Don't</u> <u>Know Where You Are Going—Leading in a Liminal Season</u> *"Solutions are achieved when 'the people with the problem' go through a process together to become 'the people with the solution. This requires more*

than changed minds—it requires changed behaviors." This is something for us to think about in the future as ministry needs and available human and financial resources change.

Council is planning several **listening sessions** in the upcoming months. These will be times to come together and share ideas and feelings about past ministry and the direction of future ministry at SCLC, including the pastoral call process. You will receive a postcard invitation to these events.

Call process. The Church Council is moving forward very deliberately with this process. We want to make sure we have a solid vision for our ministry needs before we establish a call committee, so that we call a pastor with the right gifts for our ministry needs.

Constitution Review. Greg Eiesland and I will be putting together a team tasked with reviewing the current church constitution and by-laws. The goal will be to make recommendations for an updated constitution and by-laws that better reflect our ministry and best church governance practices.

In conclusion, I would reiterate the phrase I started with and invite you to think about it more deeply. Why/How is the present time a most meaningful time to be church? I think in our collective answer we will find renewed purpose. May the peace of Christ which surpasses all our human understanding keep your hearts and minds in Christ Jesus.



enjoyed by all involved! Thanks for being a blessing! Relax and take the summer off, because we will resume this exciting ministry in the fall.



The special offering for this month is Love INC.

The purpose of Love INC is to walk alongside people on their journey to wholeness through mutual service, education, friendship and prayer. Their vision is to see people thriving in healthy relationships where they know their value, purpose and

place in Christ and our community. They involve local churches to all work together as the body of Christ. They offer a hand-

up with their service opportunities and classes.

need and foster families in their GAP ministry. In addition, they provide

furniture and diapers to program participants.

Church Business

Highlights from the April meeting:

- 1. March minutes were approved.
- 2. **Financials** PJ presented the treasurers report, Byron submitted a report showing current spending vs the budget in all areas and highlighted areas to watch, such as utilities. This will be monitored each month. Financial reports were received as presented.
- 3. **Kids Against Hunger** Pastor Chris and Kristi met with a potential person who may possibly take over this ministry, they will be talking with our former KAH director for more information and if this is a good fit. Discussion is to shut down our site, sell equipment to Sioux Falls site if no one is interested in spearheading this ministry.
- 4. **Semi-Annual Meeting date** was moved to May 21st, discussed the President would transition out, and the VP would move to President for one year. A new VP will need to be elected at this meeting.
- 5. **Church Vitality Survey** postcards with link and QR codes to be mailed out later this week along with emailed links and paper copies available to pickup.
- 6. **Strongman Competition** organizer requested the use of our parking lot and bathroom facilities for a competition on Saturday, July 8 council approved the request.
- 7. Synod Assembly is June 2-3 in Sioux Falls, delegates are needed.
- 8. **Ministry/Programming/Staffing Updates** we will not advertise for a MS/HS Youth person at this time, will wait to see if second pastor is viable first. A few HS things will be planned over the summer, no MS events are planned at this time.
- 9. **Eagle Scout Presentation** Ethan Holland presented his Eagle Scout project proposal to build a mud/play kitchen for the preschool in the fenced playground area. Council approved his project and will wait on his next step after Boy Scout council approval.
