

## A MESSAGE FROM CHURCH COUNCIL AND PASTOR CHRIS BAESLER

Dear Siblings in Christ,

At one point in Jesus' ministry, as he proclaimed the good news of God's love, his heart was moved with compassion for the hurting people around him so that He told his disciples, "*The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; therefore ask the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest.*" Then, Jesus sent his disciples out into the world as the answer to that specific prayer. This verse has been on my mind lately as we (SCLC community) continue through staffing transitions and financial changes. As the

apostle Paul tells us in Romans 12:1-8, the members of the church are the answer to the ministry needs of the present moment.

*"...by the mercies of God, present your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and acceptable to God, which is your spiritual worship. ...we who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another. We have gifts that differ according to the grace given to us: prophecy, in proportion to faith; ministry, in ministering; the teacher, in teaching; the exhorter, in exhortation; the giver, in generosity; the leader, in diligence; the compassionate, in cheerfulness."*

You and your gifts matter to God's purpose for us at SCLC to share the good news of God's love for the world. To that end, I want to make you aware of ongoing blessings and challenges in our church community and invite you to participate in an upcoming Harvest Festival as we celebrate what God is doing and imagine new possibilities.

  - ◇ Nicole Morse will be helping with leadership for Wednesday children's programming serving our Wednesday children and their families.
  - ◇ **Sunday Church School teachers needed**
- Finances: Please prayerfully consider the financials printed on page 8. Given current financial trends, we need to acknowledge that the ministry at SCLC needs to look different in the future. In the past we would hire staff to coordinate and lead programming, but we simply don't have the financial resources to address all our ministry needs in this way.

The church needs our financial resources to continue ministry; but more importantly it needs us/you; which is our wholistic engagement (our bodies as Paul says) of time, gifts, and sacrifice. A strategic planning task force has been activated to help us discern new purpose in this time and place; the past strategic plan will be utilized as intended to imagine new possibilities of ministries and where and how you can be involved.

We are planning a Harvest Festival (see details on the page 5) to celebrate God's abiding faithfulness amidst the blessings and challenges of life; to celebrate ongoing ministry; and to imagine new possibilities and ways you might bless the congregation. Know that you matter to God and God's work in the world and that whatever comes, Jesus' death was *for you* so that you might have the hope of new life always.

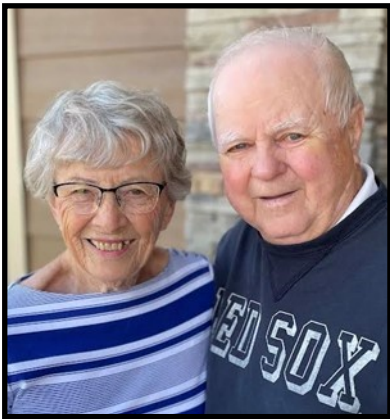

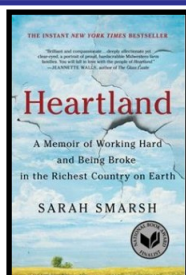


## GIVING CENTER NEEDS

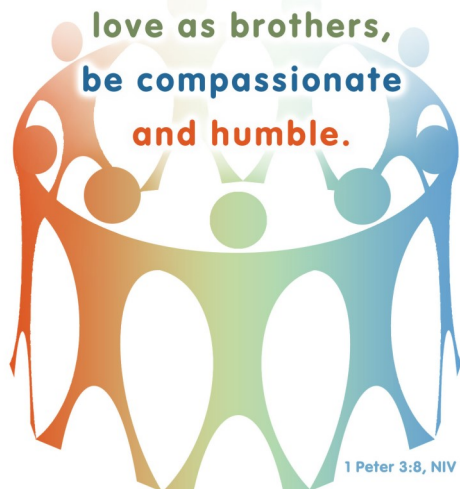

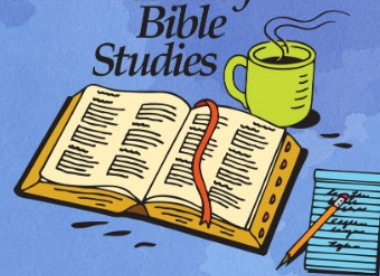

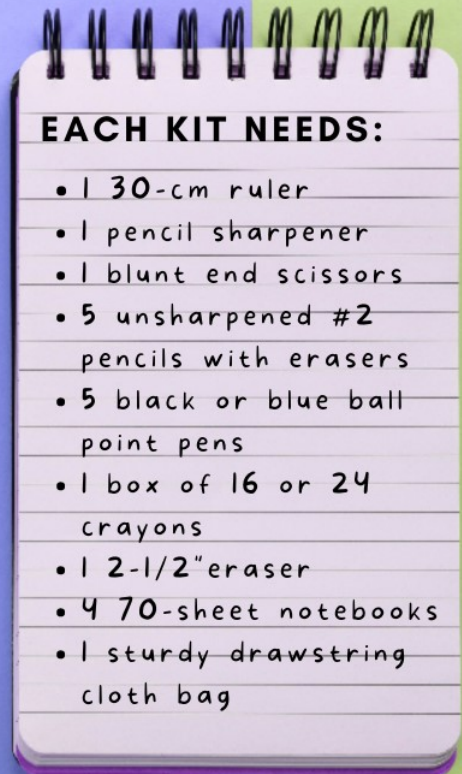

# Special Offering for September

## CORNERSTONE RESCUE MISSION



The Cornerstone Rescue Mission started with the missionary work of Dave and Cheryl Adams in the early 1980's. They first sheltered the homeless in their own residence and then created the Mission in a house at the corner of 12th and St. Joseph Streets.

Today, Cornerstone is the main provider of shelter and the only ongoing and free source of meals for the many homeless in the Black Hills region. The main facility houses as many as 160 homeless men nightly and feeds twice that many. During the holiday season, this number swells to nearly 500 served.

The Women and Children's Home opened in 2005, providing a safe place for 400 women and

children annually and provides nearly 9,500 overnight stays to their guests. They also provide low-income apartments for qualifying individuals, serve homeless veterans and serve three meals 365 days a year in their kitchen. Each meal is preceded with worship and/or devotion.

For less than \$25 a day, they provide three meals, clothing, shelter, case management and transportation to and from jobs, provision for personal needs items and Biblical counseling. They also manage the Cornerstone Thrift Store (401 11th Street) with proceeds paying for the Women and Children's Home. They accept donations during store hours daily.

Offering envelopes are in the back of the church and online donations can also be made on our website using Realm. Many of the personal items in the Giving Center have been taken to Cornerstone for many years and during the month of September, SCLC will collect toilet paper.

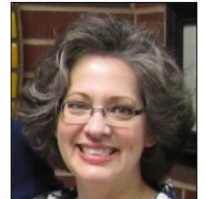
Bell Choir begins Tuesday, September 5th at 6:30 p.m. We ring for an hour each Tuesday in the sanctuary balcony.
