A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR PAUL J. ERDAL, Interim Pastor

"Arise, shine, for your light has come ..."

As I am writing this article for the December Newsletter, the first significant snowfall already happened in Northern Minnesota. This warmer weather in "The Hills" is a welcome. I've been told that this is a bit warmer than usual. However, 40s is not unusual.

As I am contemplating the month of December, I am contemplating on the darkness; the winter months of darkness specifically. In South Dakota and the Black Hills, we cannot help but also think about the cold, the sudden winter storms, and the darkness.

The ending of Daylight Savings Time (fall back) has helped the darkness in the mornings. However, we cannot ignore the fact that the daylight hours are getting shorter. The Winter Solstice usually falls on December 21st. It also marks the first day of winter. There are still 24 hours in a day, however, the sunlight on that day is the shortest in the year. Which also means that it is the darkest day in the year.

I am reminded of the verses in the Book of Isaiah ...

"Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the Lord has risen upon you. For darkness shall cover the earth and thick darkness the peoples, but the Lord will arise upon you, and his glory will appear over you. 3 Nations shall come to your light and kings to the brightness of your dawn. "

(Isaiah 60:1-3)

For those who are challenged with this seasonal change in the amount of light and darkness, namely seasonal affective disorder (SAD), it can be very difficult. I know that I have a bit of this and taking vitamin D is helpful. I also know keeping a daily regular schedule helps me tremendously.

Please be mindful of others with more severe cases of SAD. It is a challenging time with so much Darkness.

May we all find Brightness in our days these winter months. May you find the Joy and Hope in our Lord God ... "but the Lord will arise upon you, and his glory will appear over you."


