

COUNCIL MINUTES— September

Council Meeting Highlights for September 11, 2023

August Minutes were approved.

<u>Financials –</u> see chart/report, concern was raised about running in the red for too many more months

<u>Strategic Planning Team:</u> Mandey Tschetter reported that the team has met several times. They have reviewed notes from listening sessions and surveys. They are working to identify three or four strategic initiatives as a proposal for investment in the future. Youth and education stood out.

<u>Harvest Festival</u>: Dates set, the theme is "Harvest is plentiful, workers are few." Tables will be set up to celebrate everything the church offers. Also will have an area of "Imagine the possibilities" – what do we not have that is wanted?

<u>Budget & Finance Committee</u>: Prepare budget for Annual Meeting in November. Tentative date is November 12. Committee will consider what cut backs might be needed in the face of inflation and other factors.



What is Passages? Passages is a faith-based, residential re-entry program to guide and support women transitioning from incarceration or homelessness into positive sustainable life patterns. At Passages, women whose lives were shattered due to drugs, alcohol or abuse learn to build right relationships with God, themselves, and others. Initiated in 2008, with the first residents housed in 2013, Passages' loving home environment replaces the lies women believe about themselves with the truth that they are valued human beings: providing hope, opportunity and skills to reach their full potential.

Here is another joy – I wanted to share with you something that exemplifies what it is to be part of a church family – We have a retired band director who faithfully plays his trumpet each week in the Wednesday Worship Band and we have a young member who is in the 5th grade who has recently joined the band. Being new to their instrument and to playing in an ensemble, the younger student would occasionally lose their place while playing, which is easy to do when you are not playing the melody. However, that younger student continued on, because it did not take long before the retired band director leaned over and pointed to where they were as well as show that student the fingerings for the notes. It was a beautiful example of mentoring and sharing of gifts in the church family.
