

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR PAUL J. ERDAL, Interim Pastor

The Forty-Day Lenten Journey

¹² "And the Spirit immediately drove him out into the wilderness. ¹³He was in the wilderness forty days, tempted by Satan; and he was with the wild beasts; and the angels waited on him." (Mark 1:12-13)

The Gospel of Mark tells us that "the Spirit immediately drove him into the wilderness." We also know from Mark's version of the story that "[Jesus] he was with the wild beasts; and the angels waited on him." This is all we know about Jesus' time in the wilderness.

Typically, Lent is a forty-day journey beginning with Ash Wednesday. The Imposition of Ashes and the spoken words, "remember you are dust and to dust you shall return," are poignant reminders of our humanity. This year it falls on February 14th. Lent continues through Holy Week. Sundays in Lent are not counted in the Lenten Season. Sundays are days that celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus.

In other Gospel versions of the story, Jesus fasted forty days. In Luke 4:2 it says, "He ate nothing at all during those days, and when they were over, he was famished." Matthew's version is a bit more concise: "He fasted forty days and forty nights, and afterwards he was famished."

What is the longest you went without food? Do you remember fasting in Lent? What are your fond memories of Lent?

When I think about Lent, I am often drawn to my favorite childhood memory ... Friday Lenten suppers at St. Anne's Catholic Church. For a reasonable price, I recall receiving two large pieces of beer-battered cod on a plate full of homemade fries. In addition, there was coleslaw and homemade pie. What a meal!

Imagine if there was no Lent? No Lenten traditions nor routines!? Wow. I recently heard a parishioner inform me that they know of a church who does not observe a church calendar ... no Advent, Epiphany, Lent, etc. I cannot imagine that! It is part of my DNA to follow my faith in a Church Calendar Year. There is a rhythm to this faith journey.

Lent is a forty-day journey. We sojourn together to the cross of Jesus Christ on Good Friday and to Easter Sunday; the day of Resurrection and Life in Christ!

We will continue to gather as a Christian community remembering with gratitude our traditions and practices. We will remember God leads us into the future faithfully. Let us continue to be sojourners who are committed to "Sharing God's Grace."

Pastor Paul will focus on the Story of Jonah and the Whale. You may think this is a children's story, however, as soon as you "dig into the Bible" there is much more to the story. Come join us for this fascinating study followed by a soup lunch in the Fellowship Hall.



Lenten Devotions We have ordered the Lenten Devotional Booklets again this year and are asking for volunteers to read and pray a daily devotion that we will post on our Facebook page and YouTube channel just like last year! It was so wonderful and heartwarming to see and hear fellow congregation members each morning! We will again video the devotions at church ahead of the date of airing. If you'd like to participate, please contact the office to sign up. The devotional books are available to pick up at the church.



First Communion Instruction for the entire family will be offered on Saturday, March 16th, from 10:00 am to noon for all youth in 3rd through 5th grades. Anyone who has NOT had communion instruction, please contact the church office. Louise French will teach the kids how to make communion bread, which we will use at our worship service. While the bread is baking, Pastor Paul will teach about the Lord's Supper. We will conclude with a lunch for the entire family. Childcare will be provided in the nursery, as well as activities for younger children. Please contact the church if you are attending. The official "First Communion" day will be on Maundy Thursday, March 28th, at the 7:00 pm Worship Service. The families will be able to commune together around the railing.


