A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR PAUL J. ERDAL, Interim Pastor

This major event happened the Saturday of Thanksgiving weekend of 2019, and Minnesota was in covid lockdown soon after. Your patience and understanding was appreciated. The Connections with various members was an extreme delight. This "connection" is the main reason I am still in ministry. Relationships are Important and they Matter.

I invite you to be in prayerful discernment as you continue in the Call Process. Trust in the Lord. God is faithful, and always has been. God will also use you to become a blessing to others ... that's what God has always done.







CALL COMMITTEE UPDATE


