



Each week we will have salad, veggies, desserts, and hot dogs.






Michelle and her husband, Doug, have recently started attending South Canyon Lutheran Church,



CHRISTMAS SERVANT EVENT: Black Hills Pregnancy Center

We will continue to collect donations for BH Pregnancy Center until December 15. Thank you so much for all the donations under the tree and in the Blessing Basket!

- 1. <u>Giving Tree:</u> If you are interested in helping support the BH Pregnancy Center diapers, wipes, baby essentials, blankets, clothes, toys (ages newborn to 3T), you can pick up any baby item or pick a tag from the Giving Tree.
- 2. Baby Bottle Coin Bank: Collect coins for the month in their "baby bottle" and return it by Sunday, December 15.
- 3. <u>Grocery Cards:</u> Purchase cards in the office for \$25 or more. Cards will be given to the Center to purchase formula. (When you buy a grocery card, SCLC and Church Response receive a percentage of the sale. It's a triple giving!)

They offer free pregnancy screening, mentoring, fatherhood program, intentional parenting program, nurses to educate new parents, an opportunity for parents to learn and then earn diapers, baby blankets, clothes and other items.

Their mission statement is to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ to men and women facing pregnancy decisions while providing educational as well as spiritual, physical and emotional support in a loving confidential environment.

They will celebrate 40 years of being part of our community in 2025.


