## Mary stood weeping outside of the tomb... Jesus said to her, "woman, why are you weeping? Whom are you looking for"

John 21: 11a, 15-16 (NRSV)

Whom are you looking for? As we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, this question seems to still hang in the air. Whom are you looking for? As you look at the empty cross and then turn your head to look around you, whom are you looking for? As you sing the joyous alleluias but then turn around to leave the building, whom are you looking for? As you wake up Monday morning and begin your week, whom are you looking for? Who are those around you looking for?

The crowd that welcomed Jesus to Jerusalem on Palm Sunday were looking for a king with a crown on his head to overthrow the Romans so that the Jews could take their 'rightful' place once again, living their life without fear and cruel oppression. Their hope came crashing down as they saw Jesus hanging on the cross. This was not the king and savior they were looking for. Mary and her companions headed to the tomb to honor their teacher and friend by anointing his body with spices. They were looking for a dead man but instead found an empty tomb and in their grief did not recognize Jesus when he arrived in an unexpected place in an unexpected way.

Whom are you looking for this Easter season? Are you looking for someone to 'save' you and the world from all the problems? Are you looking for someone to restore the former glory that was the church and your people? Are you looking for hope and joy among your grief? Are you looking for this man, Jesus, thinking if you find him your life will be great and nothing bad will happen? Are you looking for him among the dead or among the living? Among those who appear to be the holiest or among those who society feels needs 'cleansing' the most? Whom are you looking for this Easter season? Will you recognize him when you see him? When he calls your name?

You see, sometimes when we are looking for someone with a preconceived notion of where we will find them and what they will look like, we miss the gift of the person standing right beside us. We miss seeing Jesus, who is with us in the grief and confusion and hurting of this world. When we walk forward with our head down and ears closed, we miss looking into the eyes of the 'gardener' and seeing the love of God shining into our souls. When we stay stuck looking in the past, we miss the joy and new life that has emerged all around us in places we least expect it. Grieving what we have lost does not take away the joy of what is emerging in our lives.

Whom are you looking for? Jesus is alive. He is present with you and with all of us. Calling you by name. Moving

you to new life. Encouraging you to open your eyes and ears to see him where you least expect to find him, encountering him in the least expected ways. The good news of the resurrection continues.

Jesus lives. New life continues. We are not alone!

Whom are you looking for? I pray you recognize Jesus is standing right beside you, calling your name.

## **HOLY WEEK**

Our Lenten Cantata Sunday is April 13<sup>th</sup>, Palm Sunday. Come and celebrate the triumphant entry of Christ into Jerusalem with the waving of palms and then remember the grace and love shown to us through the story of the crucifixion. This service in song is a wonderful opportunity to invite a friend to worship.

There is no Wednesday Worship, April 16, during Holy Week. Both the Maundy Thursday, April 17, and Good Friday, April 18, worship services are at 7:00 p.m. Journey with us as we gather in the "Upper Room" (Fellowship Hall) to celebrate fellowship and communion and then head to the sanctuary to experience the arrest of Jesus in the Garden for the Maundy Thursday service. Then come on Good Friday as we remember the crucifixion of our Lord through scripture and song.

There is no regular Saturday 5:30 worship on April 19. Instead, the congregation is invited to travel through the Easter Vigil Stations displayed throughout the main floor of the church. The interactive stations are designed for reflective meditation for individuals or thoughtful enlightenment for families and children. The church will be open between 2:00 -**6:00 p.m.** for you to experience this unique opportunity of reflection.

Celebrate the Risen Lord April 20 with communion at either of our Easter Sunday services; 9:00 a.m. and 11:00 a.m. The sanctuary will be decorated with Easter lilies, spring flowers and new banners, there will be special music and the procession of the cross. Easter flowers are available for purchase on Realm or stop by the church office during the week to pay for your flowers.



I'd also like to invite you to the Dakota Choral Union's final concert of the season Sunday, April 27, at 3:00 p.m. at SCLC.
