# Reflections Be a Dandelion!

The dandelions are popping up which means it is time to share my favorite devotion. I found this devotion during internship about 20 years ago. It made me change the way I look at dandelions. Every year when the dandelions peek out, I am reminded of how I am sent by God to be a dandelion.

#### **DANDELIONS!**

No matter how carefully I try to pull one up, I never get the whole thing. The root stays deep in the ground, threatening to grow up and blossom again.

But despite their bad reputation, dandelions are pretty little flowers with their yellow strands all tucked neatly into the center. And truly they are the most beautiful of all flowers when presented clutched in a child's dirty little hand. No one gets yelled at for picking them. Perhaps they grow only to be used and

enjoyed by children.

Dandelions are ignored or attacked, never nurtured or cared for, and yet they always bloom profusely. They demand no pampering or special attention to yield their bright blossoms; they pop up in fields, in lawns, and between cracks in the sidewalk, even in the best neighborhoods. Can you imagine trying to grow them in a garden? They'd sneak through the boundaries and pop their sunny yellow faces up in the surrounding lawn. They would never stay put!

neighborhoods.

We should be as easily accessible as a dandelion. Jesus was. We need to get out of our gardens and jump across the boundaries that keep us where people expect to find us. We need to show our sunny yellow faces in all the spots that need a little brightening up – the crack in the sidewalk or the lawn of a

Let those pesky, yellow flowers be a reminder to you this spring and all year long to **be a dandelion**. Dandelion long roots stay deep in the ground. We stay deeply rooted in our faith in the Triune God. Dandelions die within hours of being separated from their roots. # South Canyon Launches New Feeding Ministry!

We are thrilled to announce that we will be partnering with Feeding South Dakota in a new feeding ministry at our church! Feeding South Dakota (FSD) conducts a program to distribute food boxes on a monthly basis to around 300 low-income senior citizens in the Rapid City area. In the past, this distribution has been conducted at the FSD warehouse location in the northeast part of town. However, because these distributions pull resources away from their normal shipping/receiving/warehousing functions, they needed to find an offsite



partner who was willing to take this on. We were made aware of this opportunity, and after initial feasibility discussions, our church council approved a pilot program that will run from June-August.

During the pilot program, we will have the opportunity to learn and adjust our processes as we complete our first few distributions. We will then report back to the church council with a recommendation on continuing the program.

We have chosen to run the program on Saturday and Sunday during the second weekend of each month, conducting the distribution in 2-hour shifts from 9:00 am-3:00 pm on Saturday, and 1:00-3:00 pm on Sunday. The Saturday-Sunday distribution timeframe was chosen to provide the best possible times for food recipients or their proxies and to avoid traffic conflicts with Stevens High School, while hopefully providing the broadest possible pool of volunteers for the distributions.

The distribution will be a drive-through process in our parking lot for the recipients or their proxies. To manage this, we will typically need around 6-8 people per shift, with two people helping to direct traffic in our parking lot, two people checking-in recipients, and 2-3 people moving boxes and loading cars. This will be an excellent opportunity for individuals of various skills and interests to participate in an important ministry for our community.

We hope you agree that this new ministry is a great fit for our church. For many years, in our various surveys and focus groups, our congregation has expressed a strong interest in getting more opportunities for hands-on mission work. This opportunity allows us to serve our community while leveraging our own church facilities to do it. It also builds on our past and current focus on hunger and feeding programs as a central part of our mission and outreach efforts.

You will be hearing more about this in the weeks to come. In the meantime, we ask that you prayerfully consider becoming part of this ministry as we reach out in Christ's love to serve our community.
