## What in the world is Milestones Ministry?

When I was called to serve this congregation one of the areas I was asked to give special attention to was acknowledging spiritual milestones. In conversation with a number of congregation members and staff it became apparent there was an interest in expanding the Milestones ministry in this congregation. Mona and I put our heads together and made plans to implement new milestones this school year.

So what is Milestones ministry? Faith passage moments are occasions, developmentally predictable or serendipitously unanticipated, that foster growth in one's relationships to God, self, others, and all creation. Milestone ministry is an opportunity for the congregation to recognize one faith and/or life milestone in the life of our children each year. We are able to celebrate this milestone in worship and offer an opportunity for parents and children to receive tools to take home to continue to grow in faith. It also offers an opportunity for the congregation to pray for each of our children by name once a year.

According to Lee Hovel, the Youth & Family Institute, the purposes of the Milestone worship events are:

- to recognize and affirm each Milestone event in the life of a child and to celebrate it in the congregational worship setting;
- to equip the Christian home as the *primary* place where faith formation occurs;
- to empower the Christian home for its ministry of passing on the faith to children by modeling the importance of nurturing faith in a worship experience;
- to involve members of the congregation in supporting parents in their ministry of nurturing their children's faith;
- to support and pray for each child's faith journey as well as their parents.

To start off the year, we will be recognizing the following milestones at South Canyon Lutheran Church. (See the Children, Youth, & Family Ministries page for dates) These milestones will be offered both on Sunday mornings and Wednesday evenings during worship.

**†Back to School Blessing** - Calling all students, teachers, school staff and volunteers! Bring your backpacks, briefcases, work bags, water bottles, computers and/or lunch boxes, along with your brains and most importantly yourself to worship for our Blessing of the BBB's (Brains, Backpacks, and Book bags) milestone. The community of faith wants to surround all of you with prayer and a blessing as the school year begins. All are welcome! You don't have to be a member of SCLC to be a part of the blessing. Invite your friends to attend also.

**†Entering Middle School** (6th Graders) - Moving from elementary school to middle school is a critical time in a child's life. The middle school milestone for our 6th grade students celebrates that each child is made in the image of God. We gift each student with a mirror for their locker on which are the words "Imago Dei" to remind them daily they are made in the image of God.

**Beginning Christian Education** (4 year olds) - It is an exciting time for our preschoolers as they begin their Christian Education journey by being a part of Spark Sunday or Whirly Wednesday classes. It is also an opportunity for parents and the congregation to be reminded of the promises made at the children's baptism to provide opportunities to help children grow in faith. To mark this milestone, each child will receive a Sparkhouse Story Bible to keep at home so they can read Bible stories with their parent(s). This is the same Bible that they will use in their classrooms.

Yes, baptism, confirmation, graduation, 1st Communion and other milestones already celebrated at SCLC will continue. We are simply excited to expand our Milestones Ministry opportunities this year. We love and care about our children and this is another way, we as a congregation, can shower them with our love and with God's love.

#### Youth Immersion Trip: Serving with Heart in Sioux Falls

In July, Pastor Deb and Mona led a passionate group of middle and high school students on an immersion trip to Sioux Falls, SD, where they partnered with *Church on the Street*—a ministry committed to walking alongside those often overlooked or pushed to the margins, including the unhoused and underhoused.

Through service, conversation, and shared experience, our youth learned what it means to build relationships the way God does: by listening, asking questions, being present and consistent, and showing compassion to all of God's people.

This trip was more than just a weekend of volunteering—it was a transformative journey that deepened our students' faith, broadened their understanding of community, and reminded us all that love, inclusion, and presence can change lives.

One thing I learned is to never take anything for granted. Everyone has their own story, and no matter their situation, we all share one thing, we're human. We all face tough days, but it's important to lift each other up. - Alya

#### **Feeding South Dakota**

Thanks to all our volunteers who made our July distribution for Feeding South Dakota a success! In our inaugural distribution event, we distributed a total of 145 boxes of food (and a corresponding number of boxes of cheese). 104 boxes were distributed on Saturday, July 12, and another 41 boxes were distributed on Sunday, July 13.

In addition to our distribution day volunteers who provided their services across four two-hour shifts, we'd like to thank Joel Petersen and Gregg Brower for constructing the plywood flooring that enabled us to move the pallets of food in and out of our Narthex area, and Diane Tschetter, who coordinated all of our volunteers for the weekend, despite a series of unforeseen "twists in the road" as we got this new ministry underway.

We learned a great deal in this initial distribution which will enable us to continue to refine our processes for future distribution weekends. Overall, this was an excellent pilot of this new ministry, made possible by everyone involved, and by those who have kept this ministry in prayer. Thanks to you all!



#### Ministry of the Month - Passages Women's Transitional Living



Passages is a faith-based, residential re-entry program to guide and support women transitioning from incarceration or homelessness into positive sustainable life patterns. At Passages, women whose lives were shattered due to drugs, alcohol or abuse learn to build right relationships with God, themselves, and others. Initiated in 2008, with the first residents housed in 2013, Passages' loving home environment replaces the lies women believe about themselves with the truth that they are valued human beings: providing hope, opportunity and skills to reach their full potential.

All who have experienced the loss of a loved one are invited to gather for conversation and learning. We will pray




together and walk with one another as we grieve.





The Committees and Teams assist with the decision-making for each specific area as well as implementing various ministries and completing tasks. Each Council member serves as a liaison to one committee.

The following committees and teams are in need of additional (or new) volunteers:

**Property Committee: (Liaison - Bob Thompson, Chairperson - Gregg Brower)** This committee is responsible for maintaining and improving the church building and grounds.

**New Team Forming: Signage Team** - Pastor Deb is putting together a team to look into new signage for inside and outside the church building.

**Education Committee: (Staff - Mona, Liaison - Nichole Morse)** This committee oversees the children and adult Christian education opportunities within our congregation, including Spark Sunday, Whirly Wednesday, VBS, Confirmation and adult studies.

We are in need of volunteers to teach and assist on Sundays and Wednesdays this year.

**Community Care Committee: (Staff - Kristi, Liaison - Gary Johnson)** This newly forming committee will oversee some of the care ministries, including home communion ministers, visitation of members, card ministry and some of the care groups. Members have the opportunity to shape the duties of this committee.

**Fellowship Committee: (Staff - Pastor Deb)** This newly forming committee will also have the opportunity to shape its committee ministry description. The vision right now is for this committee to imagine, implement and oversee opportunities for SCLC members to get to know each other and build relationships.

Ministry Updates

**Education Committee:** We had a very successful week of VBS in June with over 90 kids in attendance. Day Camp was a great 3-day event in July with 16 kids participating.

**Youth Committee:** Successful immersion trip to Sioux Falls with Church on the Street. Youth Group from Nebraska was at church in July and helped tie quilts with the Piecemakers.

**Community Care:** Grief Group and Care Givers Group are meeting monthly.

**Pastor Deb's Report:** Pastoral Care has included hospital visits, home visits, office visits, funerals and burials. I will be doing a monthly gathering at the new facility at St. Martins as well as potentially a monthly worship at Echo Ridge. I have been checking into community organizations to see which ones might be a good fit for myself.

#### **Discussion/Decisions**

- 1. Council is in support of Pastor Deb scheduling time during the week to get her classwork done for the Practical Church Leadership Graduate Program she has begun.
- 2. Council approved moving forward with the possibility of a shared ministry with our associate pastor and LuMin (Lutheran Campus Ministries) at SDSMT. Members of the call committee and LuMin board will meet to discuss details and possibilities.
- 3. Finalized Constitution draft to move forward to congregation.
- 4. Denied request to host Bystander to Upstander training presentation at SCLC.
- 5. Approved expense to purchase and install windows in downstairs classroom doors.
- 6. Approved request to continue to be a Feeding SD Distribution site.
- 7. Tabled conversation concerning financially supporting Sammie Kross as she enters seminary. Pastor Deb will visit with Sammie about this.
- 8. Call Committee Update Interviewed one candidate but decided not to proceed with additional interviews. **Next meeting will be held on Wednesday, August 20 at 6:00 pm.**

General Operating Revenue: \$315,984.31

(Our offering is down from last month which is common during summer months.)

Expenses: \$327,068.40

(Our expenses are currently running under what was budgeted.)

Our current general operating checking account has a balance of \$69,571.93 as of July 17, 2025. We also have money in two money market accounts, one savings account, a building account, a memorial fund and the pastor's discretionary fund.
