# Synod Assembly Reflections

On May 30 & 31, over 400 ELCA Lutherans gathered in Sioux Falls for the SD ELCA Synod Assembly, the annual business meeting of the SD ELCA congregations. Assembly participants were invited to celebrate all the ways that we are called as individuals, as a Synod and as the Body of Christ to share the Gospel of God's love and forgiveness with the world. During our time together, we worshiped, we sang, we prayed and we ate. We connected with friends and colleagues. We participated in the Lutherans Outdoors in South Dakota's annual meeting and learned about multiple other ministries of the ELCA through speakers and panelists, including our presiding Churchwide Bishop Elizabeth Eaton. We re-elected Bishop Constanze Hagmaier to serve another six-year term as our Bishop. We re-elected Dennis Thompson, a Calvary member, as Vice President of our Synod Council. We voted on various resolutions brought to the Assembly floor. I enjoy being a part of Synod Assembly each year. It was an honor to be representing South Canyon Lutheran Church this year. Pastor Deb

Throughout the assembly, I got to experience beautiful worship services, listening to and witnessing the joy that comes from Presiding Bishop Elizabeth Eaton, energetic and engaging music, being part of the election process for our Synod Bishop, hearing greetings and information about many ministries that we support in our Synod (and around the world), and having the opportunity to hear and vote on resolutions that were introduced. One thing that brought me a lot of joy in the experience was seeing many people I have had connections with in various points of my faith journey- some went all the way back to people at my church, in my community, and in youth programs from my teenage years, so many were various connections from my summers working at Outlaw Ranch, a couple came from past pastors in our community, and a few others were participants on the LOSD Adult Trip to Holden Village I attended a couple summers ago. My overall experience attending our Synod Assembly affirmed a true sense of belonging being an ELCA Lutheran.



# Ministry of the Month – Love INC (Love In the Name of Christ)

Love INC walks alongside people on their journey to wholeness through mutual service, education, friendship and prayer. Their vision is to see people thriving in healthy relationships, knowing their value, purpose, place in Christ and our community. Involving local churches, they offer a hand-up with many service opportunities and classes.

Through Life INC, classes are offered on parenting, finances, nutrition and cooking, mentoring, children's ministry, Christianity and dealing with trauma. The Connection Center takes requests for help and referrals to local agencies. With the RISE program, participants restore furniture for sale in their store and Thrive volunteers also restore bikes for sale. Linens, bedding and kitchen items are earned by those in need and foster families in their GAP ministry. In addition, furniture and diapers are earned by program participants.

As Love INC provides a "hand-up" for those in need, they appreciate donations of new or gently used kitchenware, bedding, blankets, towels, sporting goods, and bikes (please drop them off at 414 E Omaha Street). Church Response is serving more people this summer and they are now distributing about 500 food bags per month and are in need of snack items that can go into these bags. Items


