# Give Thanks At All Times

It is easy to remember to give thanks in November as we look forward to Thanksgiving, a time when some families have the tradition to speak a word of thanks before the food can be eaten. However, Paul reminds the church of the Thessalonians to "give thanks in all circumstances, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you."

- (1 Thessalonians 5:18) Sometimes when we are overwhelmed with life we forget there are reasons to give thanks, especially in the hard times. Author Cindi McMenamin offers 17 statements of gratitude as reminders of ways to give thanks in all circumstances:
- 1. Thank you, God, for the times You have said "no." They have helped me depend on You so much more.
- 2. Thank you, God, for unanswered prayer. It reminds me that You know what's best for me, even when my opinion differs from Yours.
- 3. Thank You, Lord, for the things you have withheld from me. You have protected me from what I may never realize.
- 4. Thank You, God, for the doors You have closed. They have prevented me from going where You would rather not have me go.
- 5. Thank you, Lord, for the physical pain You've allowed in my life. It has helped me more closely relate to Your sufferings on my behalf.
- 6. Thank you, Lord, for the alone times in my life. Those times have forced me to lean in closer to You.
- 7. Thank you, God, for the uncertainties I've experienced. They have deepened my trust in You.
- 8. Thank You, Lord, for the times You came through for me when I didn't even know I needed a rescue.
- 9. Thank You, Lord, for the losses I have experienced. They have been a reminder that You are my greatest gain.
- 10. Thank You, God, for the tears I have shed. They have kept my heart soft and moldable.
- 11. Thank You, God, for the times I haven't been able to control my circumstances. They have reminded me that You are sovereign and on the throne.
- 12. Thank You, God, for those people in my life whom You have called home to be with You. Their absence from this earth keeps my heart longing for heaven.
- 13. Thank You, God, that I have an inheritance in the heavenly places...something that this world can never steal from me and I could never selfishly squander.
- 14. Thank You, God, for the greatest gift You could ever give me: forgiveness through Your perfect Son's death on the cross.
- 15. Thank You, God, for the righteousness You credited toward me, through the death and resurrection of Jesus. It's a righteousness I could never earn or attain on my own.
- 16. Thank You, Father, that You know me, You hear me, and You see my tears. Remind me through difficult times that You are God, You are on the throne, and You are eternally good.
- 17. And thank You, Lord, not only for my eternal salvation, but for the salvation You afford every day of my life as You save me from myself, my foolishness, my own limited insights, and my frailties in light of Your power and strength.

May you find reasons this month and every month to give thanks in all circumstances.

We're very pleased to report that with the completion of our fourth distribution weekend on Oct. 11-12, we have now distributed 655 food boxes to senior citizens who are in need in our community. We are incredibly grateful to our willing volunteers who have made these distributions possible. 53 members (almost half of our volunteer list) have already served at a distribution, and 29 of these volunteers have already served at more than one distribution. Please know that our collective work on this vital ministry has been greatly appreciated by both our recipients as well as our partners at Feeding South Dakota.

### Ministry of the Month - The Circle

### Helping Youth Move from Homelessness to Hope

**Family Connections Center, Inc.** works to break the cycle of homelessness for youth and young adults ages 18–24 by providing safe shelter, long-term housing, and compassionate support. Through programs like **The Circle Transitional Housing Center** and the **Safe Place Youth Shelter**, the organization empowers vulnerable youth to move toward stability and independence.

### The Circle Transitional Housing Center

- Up to 24 months of supportive housing for ages 18-24
- Focus on education, employment, and life skills
- A Housing First, trauma-informed approach
- Goal: transition to permanent, independent living

#### Safe Place Youth Shelter

- Emergency overnight shelter (11 PM-8 AM) for youth in crisis
- Up to 7 days of safe housing and case management
- Support for long-term housing or safe family reunification

#### **Support Services**

- Case management and life skills training
- Education and workforce development
- Connections to permanent housing and community resources

### A Mission Born from Compassion

Family Connections Center was founded after co-founder Joe Barb encountered a homeless youth seeking warmth one winter day—a moment that inspired him to take action. Today, the organization continues to serve youth and survivors of violence and trafficking with dignity, compassion, and hope for a better future.

We will be collecting adult hats/gloves, adult blankets/throws in addition to Walmart gift cards (purchased in the church office available in \$25and \$100 increments). These allow The Circle to provide essentials as the needs arise (i.e., coats in the correct size) for each individual. Storage space is limited. Please see the office for purchase of Walmart gift cards.

This ministry will also serve as our Christmas Servant Event. A Giving Tree will be up in early November with tags listing items needed by The Circle - Family Connections Center. Some of these include items for <u>young adults</u> - hats, gloves, socks -throws and wraps. We invite you to take a tag and help bless these young adults with gifts this Christmas season.

We would love to donate grocery gift cards (available in the office for \$25, \$50, \$100) to support their cooking and meal-preparation programs as these young adults learn important life skills. Many of them have never experienced a home-cooked meal, especially one they have prepared themselves. Additionally, if you purchase Walmart gift cards from the office, other household items and supplies can be purchased as needed.

Every season, our Family of Faith shows generosity and compassion by supporting our chosen ministry partners. Thank you for your faithfulness in giving and for showing the love of Jesus to those who may not yet know Him.


