The Season of Lent

Beginning on Ash Wednesday, February 18

Lent is a 40-day season of prayer, fasting, and repentance leading up to Easter. It symbolizes Jesus' 40 days in the wilderness. During this time we focus on spiritual renewal, self-examination, and preparation for celebrating Christ's resurrection through practices like giving up luxuries, almsgiving, and deeper devotion to God. During this Lenten season, we offer a Wednesday service at noon followed by a soup dinner, along with our Wednesday evening and weekend services. Our Wednesday noon services begin on Ash Wednesday, February 18 where our noon and 6:00 service will include communion and imposition of ashes. Beginning Ash Wednesday, February 18 & Saturday, Feb. 21 & Sunday, Feb. 22


Have you ever decided to go all in for something? Jesus shows what it is like to be all in for the reign of God. It means being fully invested, deeply committed. There are no backup options. Everything is on the line. As Christians, God calls us to a life of commitment and caring for our neighbors and our world, even when the cultures around us view our caring as naïve and our commitment as pointless. But God calls us to deep engagement.

This Lent, as we learn about God's own commitment, we'll explore how the elements of our liturgy prepare us for active engagement in the world God so loves. Our preaching, prayer, and devotional time help connect us to our neighbors, to the planet we share, and to God. This Lent, God is all in for us. Let's go all in for God's love, too.

Silent Witnesses - Midweek Worship Series

Ministry Mission Plan Updates: (Highlights of Team/Committee Meetings & other ministries)

Education

Second graders are still working through ABC Bible verses. Thank you notes have been received by scholarship recipients. VBS will be July 20-23. We will not be hosting an LO Day Camp this year. The schedule for the remainder of the education year was reviewed. A SparkHouse curriculum is being used for 8th grade Confirmation and middle school will be doing monthly service projects instead of prayer journals.

Property Committee

Moved memorial plaque and took down wooden bench as part of the Playground Makeover. Adjusted some doors. Added door handle to preschool door by dumpster. Patched walls by downstairs piano. Hung sensory boards on the walls. Could use a skidsteer to move shed if we want it back in original spot. The windstorm in December moved the shed about 2 feet. Trailer needs to be moved.

Worship

The worship teams joined forces to greet, usher and provide communion to roughly 800 faithfuls for the 3 services on Christmas Eve. Christmas Eve services went well.

Outreach

Feeding SD will be shortening shifts from 2 hours to 90 minutes since the busiest time is during the beginning. Tim and Cheryl are in conversation about taking boxes to a couple of the low income high rises. No decision has been made yet. 139 boxes distributed in January.

Community Care

The Grief Group and Care Giver Support Group gatherings have been suspended.

Fellowship Committee

The pizza party and tour of lights went well in December. The Third Saturday Suppers are going well. In March we are going to host bingo following the Third Saturday Supper.

Pastor Deb's Report

I am attending the Bear Butte Conference Leaders Retreat the afternoon of Feb 1 – morning of Feb 3. I will be on vacation the afternoon of February 15 – 17. Garet is finishing another rug for the church which will hang downstairs in the fellowship hall. It is titled “Window of Creation” and was inspired by part of the Creation window.

Treasurer's Report & Financial Mission Plan Update:

The statement of activity for January - December, 2025 was reviewed. Our general operating income for 2025 was \$678,661.22. Our operating expenses were \$675,630.56. These expenses were about \$40,000 under the expenses approved in the 2025 financial mission plan. As of January 16, 2026, the balances in the bank accounts were: General operating checking - \$73,299.99, General MM - \$154,549.66, Savings - \$41,523.42, Savings MM - \$63,327.40, Building Fund - \$56,033.73, Memorial Fund - \$77,838.84, Food Certificates - \$8,618.92, Pastor's Discretionary Fund - \$2,039.71

Other Discussion/Decisions:

*A wall is being built to replace the grey dividers in the sanctuary. This area will continue to house the Feeding SD Supplies.

*Two old furnaces will be replaced. They are furnaces which heat some of the downstairs classrooms.

*The Call Committee will be conducting a second interview with a candidate.

*The terms of nine council members will be completed in May, 2026. Pastor Deb will be speaking with these members individually to see if they would like to be nominated for re-election in May. Nominating Committee includes Gary Johnson, Carrie Churchill, Brent Ziegler, Carol Stiles and Diane Tschetter.

It is an exciting time to be a part of South Canyon Lutheran Church. The Holy Spirit is at work and there is much joy and excitement in the air. Thank you for being a part of this joy and excitement through your giving of your gifts, including your financial gifts.

Your giving is extremely important. Our total revenue for 2025 was \$678,661.22. Our total expenses were \$675,630.56. Our expenses were about \$40,000 less than approved in our 2025 financial mission plan. By each of us financially giving what we could, we were able to start 2026 with a positive balance in our operating account. This is news to celebrate!

Financial giving is about more than just the numbers. Think about the ministry that happened within your congregation during 2025, because everyone worked together in the giving of their time, talents and resources. Children and Youth ministries are expanding. We gathered for worship, heard the preached Word of God, partook in the sacraments, sang, prayed, learned and connected with each other. We fed students and families both physically and spiritually. We supported the work of multiple organizations, touching the lives of thousands of individuals, through the Ministries of the Month. We partnered with Feeding SD to distribute food boxes to senior adults in our community. We began the search for an Associate Pastor. We welcomed new members. We celebrated baptisms. (Just to name a few things that happened in 2025). The Holy Spirit is at work. So exciting.


We offer 3 different program options -
