Pieces of Us

This past month, a small contingent of the Piecemakers were able to tour the Canyon Hills Center in Spearfish. It is a psychiatric residential treatment center under the umbrella of Lutheran Social Services and funded by Medicare. This facility is licensed to care for 10- to 17-year-olds "who have emotional, behavioral, and educational challenges. Offers specialized education program, extensive outdoor recreation, opportunities for community involvement, and evidence-based programming including cognitive behavior therapy (CBT) groups."



Our tour was led by Michelle, the facility director, who has been there for 19 years. She loves what she does and shared with us facts about the facility and residents. The thing that struck us the most was when she told us that the majority of the residents have tried to commit suicide 5 or 6 times. Let that sink in for a moment. To these children, their life is so out of control or unbearable that they choose suicide not once, but multiple times. As sobering as this was, we were able to see where these children were given the chance and resources to heal and grow. Though they must follow strict guidelines and schedules, they are given a strong sense of structure and understanding. With a ratio of 1 staff per 5 residents, along with various other office staff, teachers and counselors, these young people are surrounded by many who love and care for them.

The facility can accommodate 32 residents, divided between 2 wings. They currently have 27, with each child having their own room. Both boys and girls live on each of the wings. Most are at the facility for 9 to 12 months. About 60 children go through the programs each year. Several people and organizations from the Spearfish area donate their time and money to help out. One church provides gifts for Christmas, while others give games, snacks, and other needed items. LSS also provides quilts that are donated from groups like ours.

We all agreed that this was a very eye-opening experience for us. Piecemakers appreciate the opportunities we get to visit some of the various organizations we donate to each year. It helps keep us connected to our mission and broader community. Thanks to Jessica Lillebo from LSS for setting up this tour and Michelle for being so gracious with her time.

Oh, and one more thing. We stopped and had a nice lunch at The Farmhouse Bistro and Bar. Delicious food and great service. Make sure to check it out if you are heading that way.

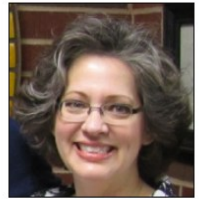

Ministry of the Month – Esthers Rising: Hope for Young Survivors



Esthers Rising was founded in 2020 after recognizing the urgent need to support adolescent survivors of human trafficking in the Black Hills. As a faith-based nonprofit, its mission is to provide hope, healing, and a pathway to restoration.

Through the Free23 Program, survivors receive counseling, life skills training, transportation, and other essential resources, removing barriers to the care they need. By the end of 2024, the program had served 14 young survivors. Looking ahead, Esthers Rising's vision is to open a restorative care home where girls can safely live for up to 18 months while healing, rebuilding their lives, and preparing for a hopeful future.

Everything this ministry accomplishes is made possible through the generosity, prayers, and encouragement of supporters who believe every young person deserves hope, healing, and a new beginning. 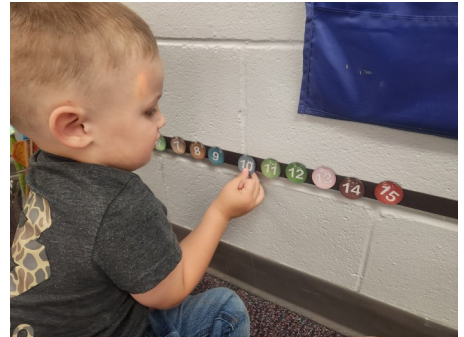

Ministry Mission Plan Updates: (Highlights of Team/Committee Meetings & other ministries)

Education: 91 kids attended VBS with over 40 volunteers. The curriculum team met to review education programs for the next church year.

Youth: Youth trip to Sioux Falls is Thursday, July 30—Saturday, August 1.

Property Committee: New roof on the shed. Fixed the door locking mechanism. Adjusted the women's bathroom door on the main level. Replaced shingles on church roof. Cleaned out and organized the shed. Removed old grill from behind the shed. Sold black trailer.

Outreach: Discussed how to reach out to our surrounding neighbors. Talked about ways to connect with and involve our preschool families. Discussed offering a speaker series on different topics. Will use the grocery cart in the entrance way for ongoing food support for Lutheran Campus Ministries and SDSMT.

Fellowship Committee: 20+ people were at the Post 22 baseball game on July 19. Looking at dates to gather people to go watch high school football games.

Other Discussion/Decisions:

*Bylaws were brought forth by the Bylaws Task Force. After discussion and some edits the proposed bylaws were approved with amendments. They will be taken to the congregation for voting in November.

*A new coffee maker will be purchased to be placed in the kitchen.

*A half-day council retreat was scheduled for October 3.

*The edging around the landscaping on the preschool door side of the building is still being worked on.

*Interest rates were discussed and questions were asked about getting more for our money. Kelly and Kristi will investigate this more.

*Pastor Deb shared her final applied project presentation with the council.
